PROGRAM DETAILS

Up to 12 college students from the South Texas region are selected to participate in a 3-year, longitudinal program comprising of consecutive summer research intensives in addition to educational enrichment and research commitments during the school year. The STUROP program requires considerable effort from each participant, therefore, no other major activities should be planned during the duration of the summer program. There are also many activities scheduled throughout the academic school year which students are expected to make every effort to attend. Reimbursement for transportation costs may be available based on individual need. Students will be expected to summarize their research findings either as a poster presentation, a written abstract, or as an oral presentation, varying by program year.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants must have 2 letters of recommendation and be classified as rising Sophomores in the 2024-2025 school year. Criteria used to select candidates include academic performance, extracurricular activities and leadership. Applicants who advance through first phase of application process will be invited to the second phase, the interview. The 2024 STUROP summer intensive component will occur from June 3 - August 2, 2024.
